



COVID -19 GUIDELINES

We are fully committed to stopping the spread of Covid 19 and protecting our staff and our course participants.

Sanitisation

Our building facilities including check in/change rooms and toilets and our equipment (e.g. boats) will receive a regular preventative anti-bacterial cleaning throughout the day.

Hand sanitise stations will be located throughout our site at key areas.

Changing facilities

We would encourage participants to arrive ready to sail. Access to changing facilities will be staggered to ensure minimum contact and social distancing.

Equipment

Due to current circumstances the Royal Western Yacht Club of Ireland cannot provide wetsuits. Buoyancy aids will be cleaned daily with Milton solution which is the industry standard best practice.

Participants will be assigned a boat for each session. Swapping/changing of boats will not be permitted during a session.

Staff training

All our staff have received Covid 19 training and in particular Covid 19 prevention protocols.

Pre Health Screening Form

The pre-health screening form will be emailed to you prior to your course start date. Please do not visit us if you answer yes to any of the questions.

Questions include:

- If you currently have Covid-19 or are displaying symptoms of Covid-19 in the last 14 days
- If you live in the same household or have been in close contact with someone who has displayed symptoms of Covid 19 in the last 14 days
- If you have been advised to cocoon at this time
- If you have been advised to self-isolate at this time
- If you have travelled abroad in the last 14 days (except Northern Ireland)

We have adapted our cleaning and hygiene schedule with frequent cleaning and particular attention to touchpoints. All our staff have received Covid 19 training before returning to work.
